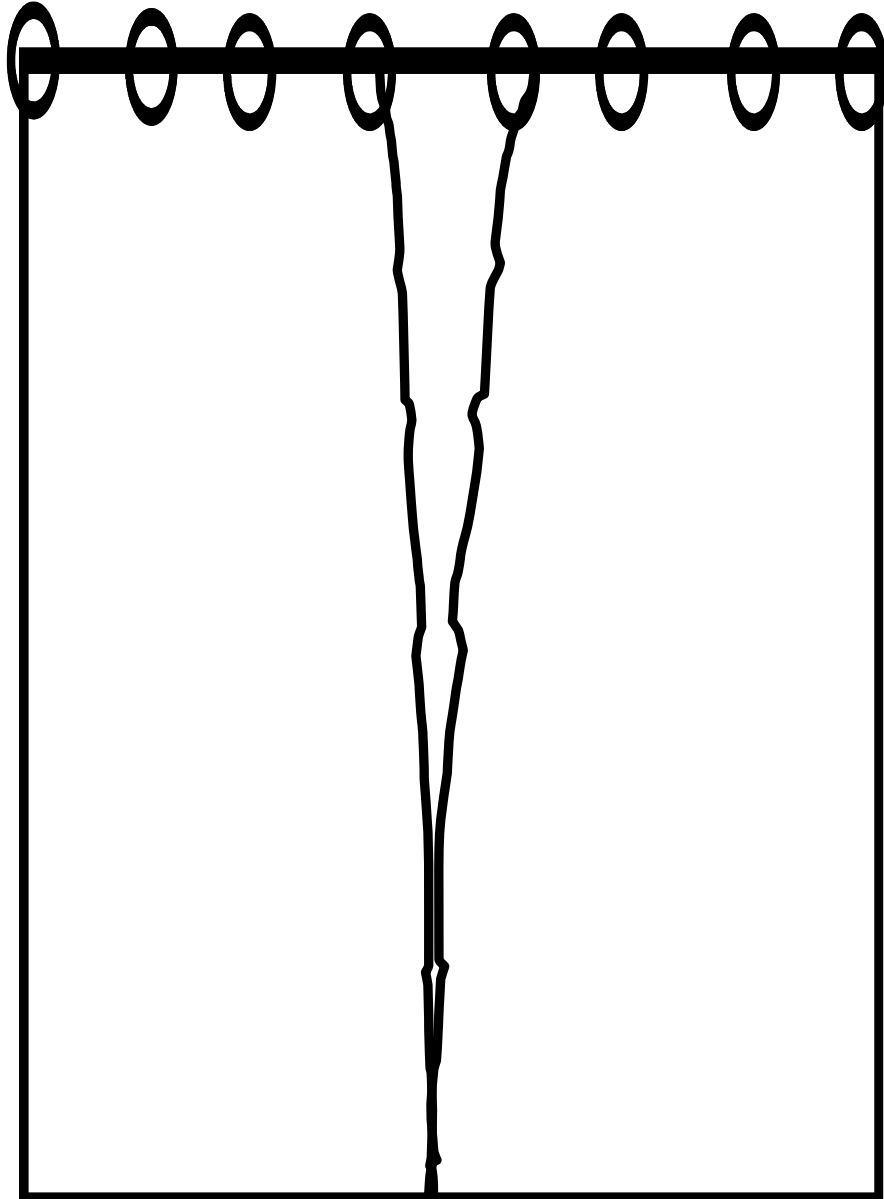



# JESUS Opened the Way to God the Father

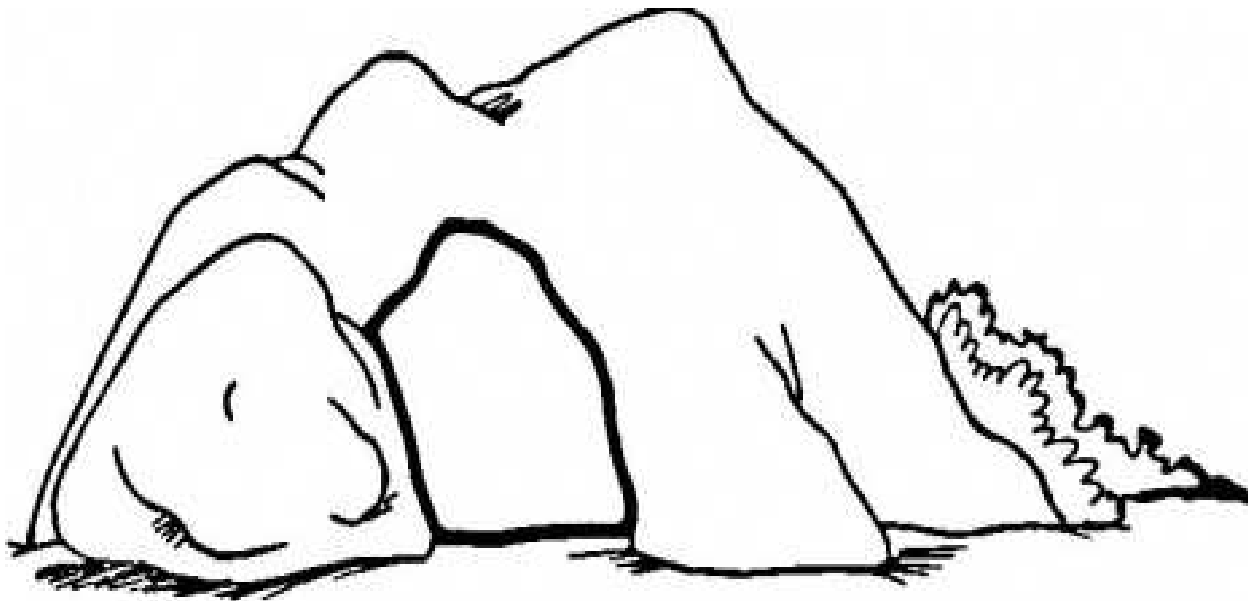
# JESUS Was Buried

Matthew 27:57-61, John 19:38-42, Luke 23:50-56, Mark 15:42-47

After **JESUS** died, a man named Joseph, who was a disciple of **JESUS**, went to Pilate and asked him for **JESUS**' body. Pilate ordered the soldiers to give **JESUS**' body to Joseph.

Joseph took His body and wrapped it in a clean linen cloth. Then, Joseph placed **JESUS**' body in his own new tomb that had been cut out of the rock. Mary Magdalene and the other Mary were there watching as **JESUS** was placed in the tomb.

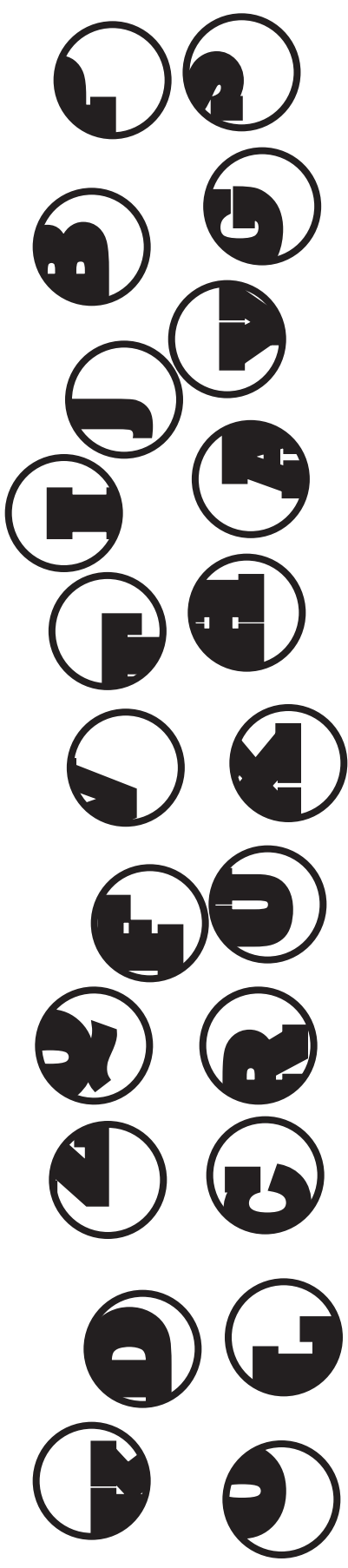
Joseph rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away.



Pilate ordered the soldiers to seal the rock and he placed soldiers there to guard the tomb. The Jewish leaders were afraid that someone would steal **JESUS**' body and tell people that He had risen from the dead.

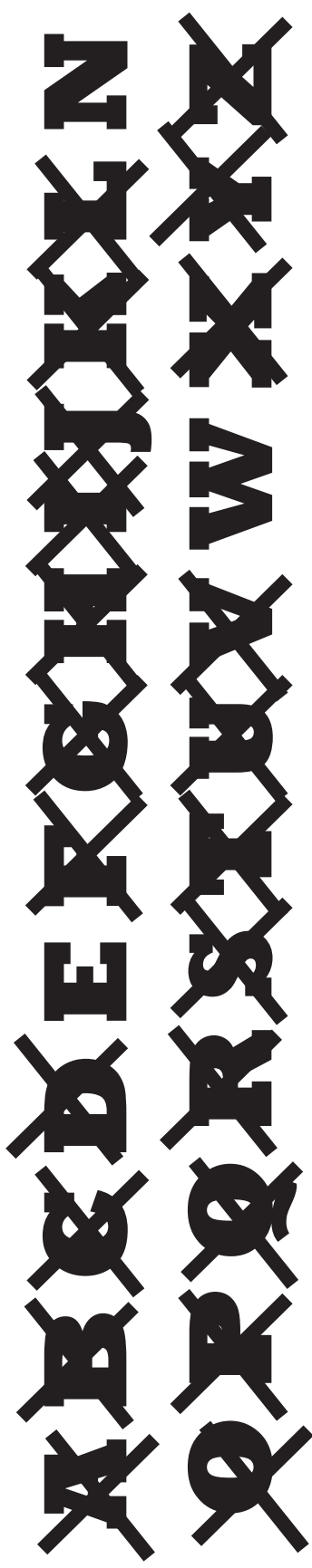
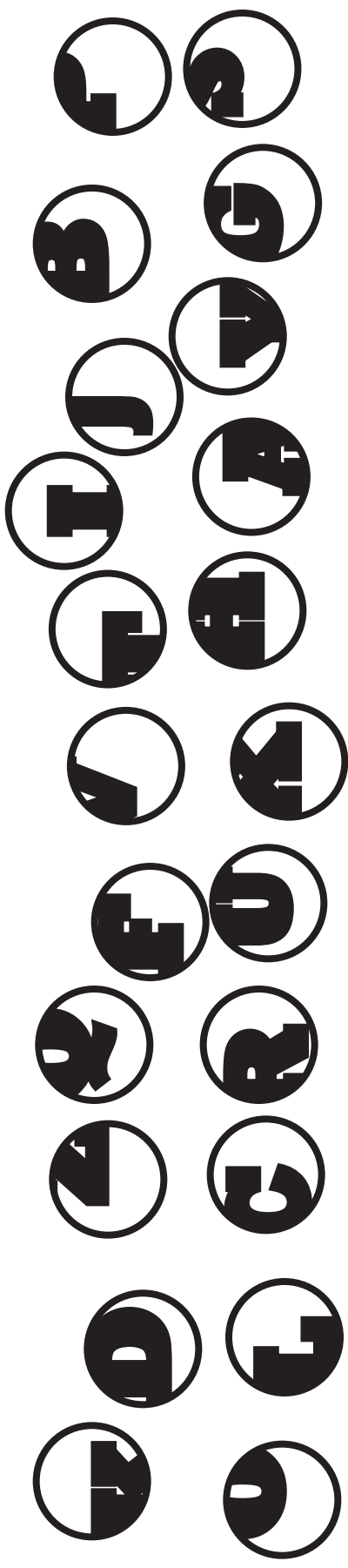

# Close-up Comfort Solution

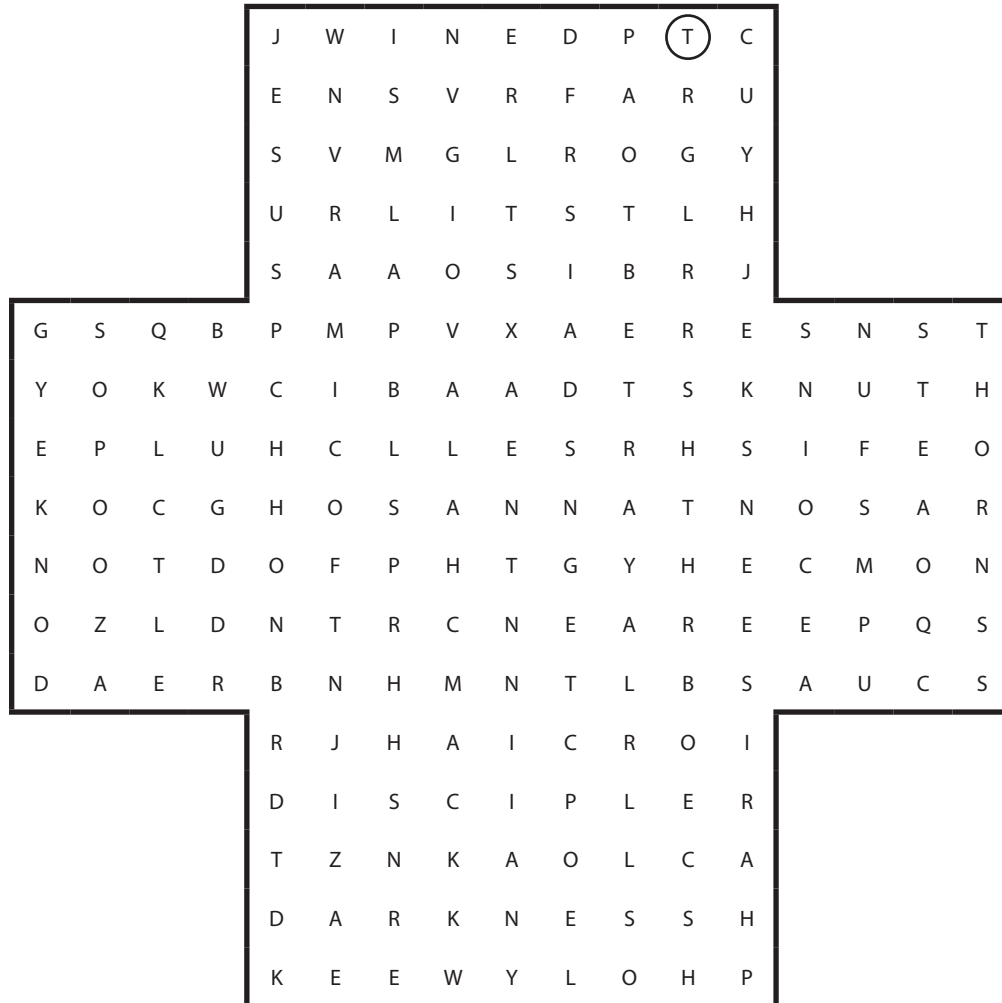

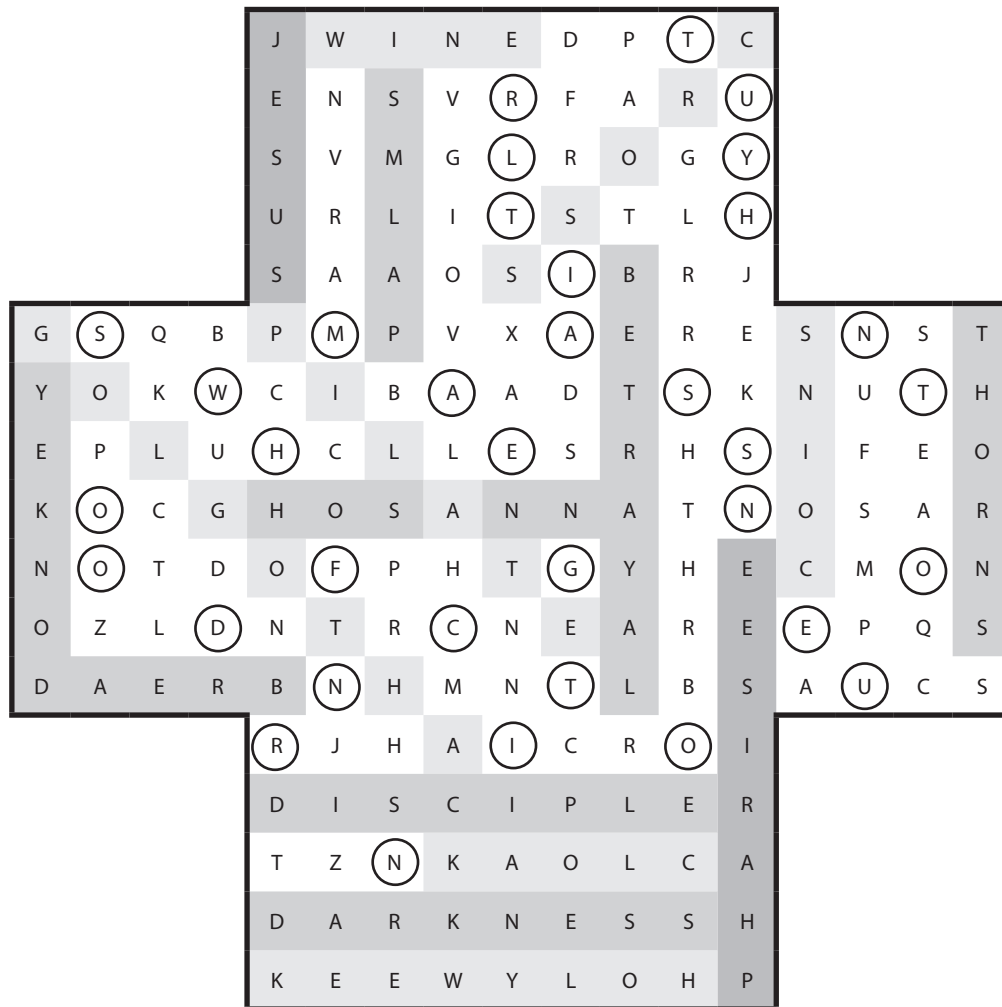
