JESUS turned over the money changer's tables and

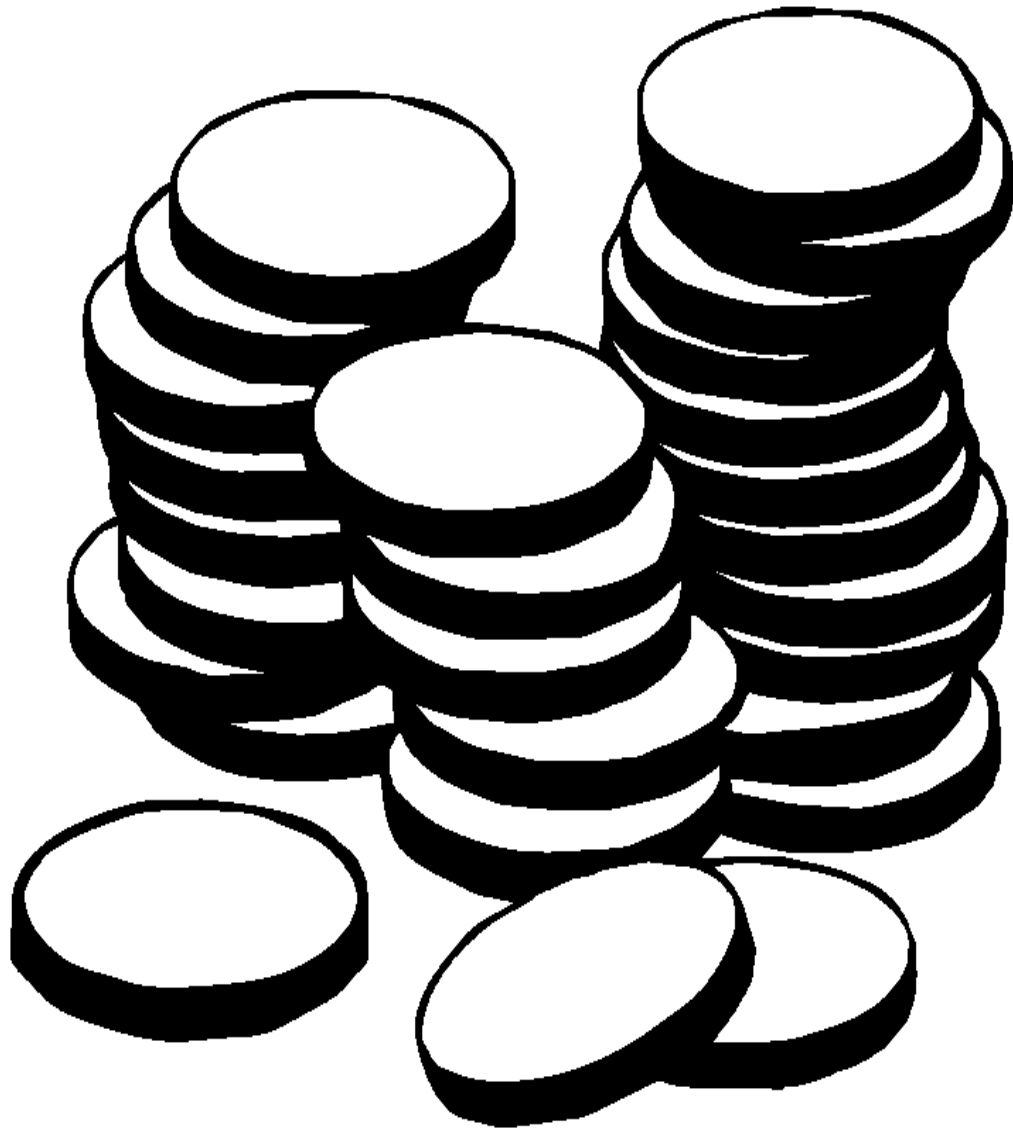
the benches of the people who were selling  (doves) and kicked them out of the temple.

John 13:1-17
