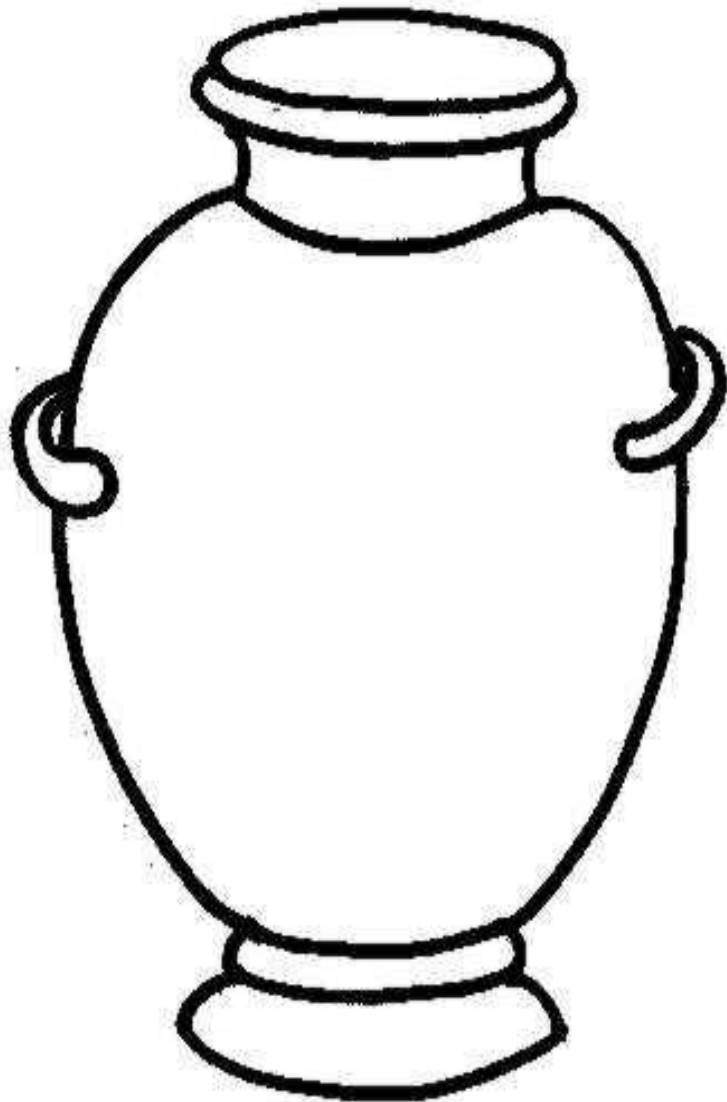


# JESUS is Anointed

John 12:12-19, Luke 19:28-40, Matthew 21:1-11

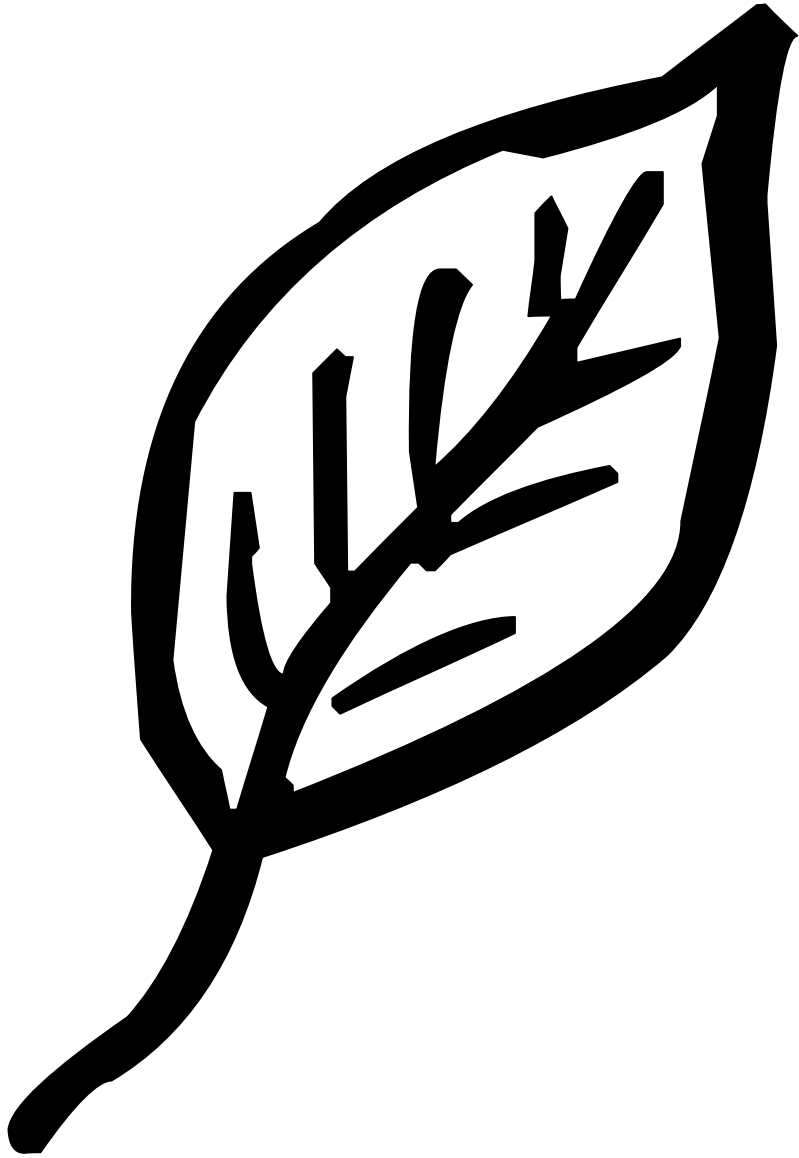
A big crowd of people had come to **Jerusalem** to celebrate Passover. The people heard that **JESUS** was on his way to **Jerusalem**.
